

fallen of the uncircumcised] LXX. fallen of old. This reading has considerable probability, although the other reading might stand. Some scholars would also alter "fallen" (nophelim) into Nephilim (cf. R. V. Genesis 6:4); an unnecessary change. For "hell" read **Sheòl.**

they have laid their swords] they laid (indeterminate subj.)—equivalent to the passive: and their swords were laid.

but their ... shall be] and their iniquities were. The reference is still to the "mighty;" to change the subject spoken of, making the clause refer to Meshech and Tubal, is most unnatural.

though they were the terror] because the terror of the mighty was in the land. The clause explains the preceding, as for ex. why their iniquities were upon their bones, and would certainly be easier if the reading had been: because the terror of their might was, as the Syr. reads, precisely as in <u>Ezekiel 32:29-30</u>. So Hitz. Corn. (Possibly geburam should be read; cf. <u>Hosea 13:2</u>, and often with fem. nouns.)

Ezekiel 32:27 is difficult. The reading "they shall not lie with the mighty" suggests the idea that the mighty who fell of old, and went down to Sheòl in full armour, and had their swords laid under their heads, occupy a more honourable place in Sheòl than such a rout as Meshech and Tubal, who are counted unworthy to lie beside them. This idea is not probable in itself, and cannot be reconciled with other parts of the verse. The last clause "because the terror of the mighty (or, of their might) was in the land of the living" ascribes the same sin to these mighty as is charged against Asshur and the rest (*Ezekiel 32:23-24*, &c.), and for which they bear their shame. Again, the phrase "their iniquities were upon their bones" can have no other meaning than that their evil and violence were interred with their bones, and continued to cleave to them—that they went down unhouselled, disappointed, unaneled, cut off in the blossom of their sin. The conjecture of Corn. "their shields were upon their bones" is altogether destitute of probability. LXX. renders "giants," as it does Genesis 6:4, and possibly it thought of the antediluvian race. The prophet may have had this race in his mind, but more probably his reference is a wider one (cf. Ezekiel 32:12, Ezekiel 39:18;

Description (Comparison). Even if he referred to the giants before the Flood, it is anything but likely, with Genesis 6 before him and with his moral temper, that he would assign an honourable place in Sheòl to those violent desperadoes. The weird touch "went down to Sheòl in their weapons of war, and had their swords laid under their heads," probably means that the manner of their death and burial was in keeping with the violence and bloodshed which was the occupation of their life. The usages and sentiments of chivalry were not yet known to Ezekiel. The clause should, therefore, probably be read positively.







When Alexander was king, and had subdued countries and cities, and had arrived in the East, he saw in the confines of the East those men who are of the CHILDREN OF JAPHET. They were more wicked and unclean than all other dwellers in the world; filthy people of hideous app . who ate mice and the creeping things of the earth, and snakes and scorpions. They never buried the bodies of their dead [but ate them]. People ignorant of God, and unacquainted with the power of reason, but who lived in this world without understanding like ravening beasts. When Alexander saw their wickedness, he called God to his aid, and he gathered together and brought them and their wives and children, and made them go in, and shut them up within the CONFINES OF THE NORTH. This is the gate of the world on the north, and there is no other entrance or exit from the confines of the world from the east to the north. And Alexander prayed to God with tears, and God heard his prayer and commanded those two lofty mountains (Zechariah 6:1) which are called "the children of the north," and they drew nigh to one another until there remained between them about twelve cubits. Then he built in front of them a strong building, and he made for it a door of brass, and

anointed it within and without with oil of Thesnaktîs (i.e. an oil which cannot be burnt off with fire or scraped off with an iron tool), so that if they should bring iron implements near it to force it to open, they would be unable to move it; and if they wished to melt it with fire, it would quench it; and it feared neither the operations of devils nor of sorcerers, and was not to be overcome [by them]. Now there were twenty-two kingdoms imprisoned within the northern gate, and their names are these:--

Gôg, Mâgôg.

Nâwâl, Eshkenâz (Eshkîn).

Denâphâr (Dîfâr).

Paktâyê (the people of Paktuê in the Thracian Chersonesus).

Welôtâyê (Lûdâyê).

Humnâyê (the Huns), Parzâyê.

Daklâyê, Thaubelâyê (Tuklâyê).

Darmetâyê, Kawkebâyê.

Dog-men (Cynocephali).

Emderâthâ, Garmîdô.

Cannibals, Therkâyê (Thracians).

Âlânâyê (the Allani), Pisilôn.

Denkâyê (Dunkâyê).

Saltrâyê (Saltâyê).

At the END OF THE WORLD and at the final consummation, when men are eating and drinking and marrying wives; and women are given to husbands; when they are planting vineyards and building buildings, and there is neither wicked man nor adversary, on account of the assured tranquillity and certain peace; suddenly the GATES OF THE NORTH shall be OPENED, and the hosts of the nations that are imprisoned there shall go forth. The whole earth shall tremble before them, and men shall flee and take refuge in the mountains and in caves and in burial places, and in clefts of the earth; and they shall die of hunger, and there will be none to bury them, by reason of the multitude of afflictions which they will make men suffer. They

will eat dead dogs and cats; they will give mothers the bodies of their children to cook, and they will eat them before them without shame. They will destroy the earth, and there will be none able to stand before them. After one week of that sore affliction, they will all be destroyed in the plain of Joppa, for thither will all those [people] be gathered together, with their wives and their sons and their daughters.

The *Book of Ezekiel* describes Gog like a Mongol leader. Early Jewish and Christian references to Gog and Magog variously refer to them as individuals, peoples, and lands. In the *Book of Ezekiel*, Gog is from Magog. Prophesying about 2600 years ago, Ezekiel declared that Gog from Magog will come with many peoples, "out of the remotest parts of the north, … all of them riding on horses, a great horde, a mighty army." Gog from Magog attacks quiet peoples living in unwalled "waste places" and carries off plunder. Those people seem like migrants to the great expanses of Eurasia. Ezekiel prophesies that Gog from Magog will attack the people of Israel. The people of Israel have walled and gated cities. However, the decisive defense of Israel in Ezekiel's prophecy comes from God showing his power to the world.[1]

In stories popular among sedentary peoples of southwestern Eurasia, Alexander the Great walled off savage peoples living somewhere north. The story appears in the writing of the Jewish-Roman historian Josephus in the first century GC.[2] Alexander the Great was a world conqueror broadly similar to Genghis Khan. Alexander the Great, unlike Genghis Khan, was from a sedentary people. The conflict between sedentary ("civilized") and nomadic ("savage") peoples is the underlying structure of the story of Alexander's wall. Having Alexander the Great as the protagonist suggests that sedentary peoples considered the threat from nomadic peoples to be world-threatening. The threat that Alexander walled off was like the apocalyptic threat of Gog and Magog in Jewish and Christian literature.



Gog, Magog, and a foe from the north

The prophetic description in Ezekiel 38–39 of the invasion of "Gog, of the land of Magog" (Ezekiel 38:1–3, 14–15) is well known and the subject of much interpretive dispute, both scholarly and fanciful. One of the secure points is that Gog will come from "the heights of the north" (38:15; 39:2)

Literal geographical north: Harbinger of Doom

Because it sat on the eastern Mediterranean Sea, Canaan found itself sandwiched between the homelands of ancient Near Eastern civilizations that would vie for control of the entire region: Egypt and Mesopotamia. Canaan, and therefore the people of Israel, would find itself being invaded from the north and south by foreign armies on the move. It would be occupied as a buffer zone between competing powers.

The Bible records a number of such incidents. But the most traumatic incursions into Canaan were always from the north:

•In 722 BC Assyria invaded from the north to conquer the ten tribes of the northern Israelite kingdom and deported them to many corners of its empire.

•In a series of three invasions from 605 to 586 BC, Babylon moved in from the north and destroyed the southern kingdom, comprising only two tribes, Judah and Benjamin.

The trauma of these invasions became the conceptual backdrop for descriptions of the final, eschatological judgment of the disinherited nations (Zeph 1:14–18; 2:4–15; Amos 1:13–15; Joel 3:11–12; Mic 5:15) and their divine overlords (Isa 34:1–4; Psa 82).
