

MALE CHILD

Revelation 12:2-5 "And she being with child cried,
travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

3 And there appeared another wonder in heaven:
and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns,
and seven crowns upon his heads.

4 And his tail drew the third part
of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth;
and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered,
for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

5 And she brought forth a man child, who was to
rule all nations with a rod of iron; and her child was
caught up unto God, and [to] his throne.

6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a
place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a
thousand two hundred [and] threescore days. " KJV



Isaiah 66:6-9 "The sound of noise from the city! A voice from the temple! The voice of the LORD, Who fully repays His enemies! 7 "Before she was in labor, she gave birth; Before her pain came, She delivered a male child. 8 Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Shall the earth be made to give birth in one day? [Or] shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as Zion was in labor, She gave birth to her children. 9 Shall I bring to the time of birth, and not cause delivery?" says the LORD. "Shall I who cause delivery shut up [the womb]?" says your God." NKJV

JOB

Job 3:1-10 "After this Job opened his mouth and cursed the day of his [birth]. 2 And Job spoke, and said: 3 "May the day perish on which I was born, And the night [in which] it was said, 'A male child is conceived.' 4 May that day be darkness; May God above not seek it, Nor the light shine upon it. 5 May darkness and the shadow of death claim it; May a cloud settle on it; May the blackness of the day terrify it. 6 [As for] that night, may darkness seize it; May it not rejoice among the days of the year, May it not come into the number of the months. 7 Oh, may that night be barren! May no joyful shout come into it! 8 May those curse it who curse the day, Those who are ready to arouse Leviathan. 9 May the stars of its morning be dark; May it look for light, but [have] none, And not see the dawning of the day; 10 Because it did not shut up the doors of my [mother's] womb, Nor hide sorrow from my eyes." MOSES

Exodus 1:17 But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive." NKJV

SAMUEL

1 Samuel 1:11 "Then she made a vow and said, "O LORD of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a male child, then I will give him to the LORD all the days of his life, and no razor shall come upon his head." NKJV

JEREMIAH

Jeremiah 20:14-18 "Cursed [be] the day in which I was born! Let the day not be blessed in which my mother bore me! 15 Let the man [be] cursed Who brought news to my father, saying, "A male child has been born to you!" Making him very glad. 16 And let that man be like the cities Which the LORD overthrew, and did not relent; Let him hear the cry in the morning And the shouting at noon, 17 Because he did not kill me from the womb, That my mother might have been my grave, And her womb always enlarged [with me]. 18 Why did I come forth from the womb to see labor and sorrow, That my days should be consumed with shame?" NKJV

YAHUSHA

Mathew 2:16 "Then Herod, when he saw that he was deceived by the wise men, was exceedingly angry; and he sent forth and put to death all the male children who were in Bethlehem and in all its districts, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had determined from the wise men." NKJV

First Borne/First Fruits

Exodus 22:29 "Thou shalt not delay [to offer] the first of thy ripe fruits, and of thy liquors: the firstborn of thy sons shalt thou give unto me." KJV

Revelation 14:1-5 "And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty [and] four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. 2 And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: 3 And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred [and] forty [and] four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth. 4 These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, [being] the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb. 5 And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God." KJV

Borne From Above

John 3:3 "Jesus answered and said to him, `Verily, verily, I say to thee, If any one may not be born from above (*"anōthen"* John 3:31), he is not able to see the reign of God;" ^{YLT}

1 John 3:9 "Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God." ^{KJV}

John 14:20-21 "At that day ye shall know that I [am] in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you. 21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him." ^{KJV}

Matthew 1:8 "Jesus came out from the temple and was going away when His disciples came up to point out the temple buildings to Him. 2 And He said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Ark of the Covenant Testament

Exodus 16:32-34 “And Moses said, This [is] the thing which the LORD commandeth, Fill an omer of it to be kept for your generations; that they may see the bread wherewith I have fed you in the wilderness, when I brought you forth from the land of Egypt. 33 And Moses said unto Aaron, Take a pot, and put an omer full of manna therein, and lay it up before the LORD, to be kept for your generations. 34 As the LORD commanded Moses, so Aaron laid it up before the Testimony, to be kept.” ^{KJV}
